The following constitution and by-laws were adopted at meeting Dec. 11, 1952.

C O N S T I T U T I O N

ARTICLE I Name

This chapter shall be known as the Nashville Chapter No. 227 of the National Association of Retired United States Civil Employees.

ARTICLE II Objects

The objects of this Chapter shall be those set forth in the Certificate of Incorporation of the National Association of U.S. Retired Civil Employees. In furtherance of these objects the Chapter shall act conformably to the By-Laws of the said National Association.

ARTICLE III Membership

The active and associate membership of this Chapter shall be composed only of those who respectively are active or associate members in good standing of the National Association of Retired U.S. Civil Employees, being residents of Nashville, Tenn. or its immediate vicinity. Only active members may hold office. No person eligible as above shall be excluded from Chapter membership except he be of disreputable character.

ARTICLE IV Officers

The Chapter shall elect a President, a Secretary and such other officers as are named in the By-Laws thereof. These shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified.

ARTICLE V Dues

The Chapter shall collect for its own treasury only such dues as may be necessary to meet expenses in carrying on its business and functions.

ARTICLE VI Delegates

Delegates to the National Convention shall be elected by the Membership of the Chapter after the date and place of the Convention have been announced by the National office.

ARTICLE VII By-Laws and Amendments

Sec. 1. This constitution cannot be amended without the approval of the National Executive Committee.

Sec. 2. The Chapter shall adopt such By-Laws, not inconsistent with the Chapter Constitution, as shall seem appropriate and necessary for the functioning of the Chapter, and shall provide the method by which those By-Laws may be amended. Notice in writing of the proposed amendments must be transmitted to all Chapter members not less than ten days before action thereon.

B Y - L A W S

ARTICLE I Meetings of the Chapter

The regular meetings of the Chapter shall be on the last Thursday of each month at 8:00 P.M., but subject to change by not less than fifteen members, including officers, present at meeting. Not less than fifteen members shall constitute a quorum to act at such meetings.

Sec. 2. The President shall call special meetings of the Chapter when he deems it necessary, or upon written request of fifteen members (a quorum), stating the nature of the business for which the meeting is called. Notice of all special meetings shall be given in writing and mailed to every member at his last known address or delivered personally at least seven days before such meeting.

Sec. 3. A quorum shall consist of fifteen members, including officers, of the Chapter, but less than a quorum may adjourn to meet on a future date when a quorum is present, of which due notice shall be given to all members.

ARTICLE II Order of Business

The following shall be the order of business at all regular meetings.

1. Call to order by the President
2. Invocation by the Chaplin
3. Reports of Officers
4. Reading of the minutes of previous meeting
5. Reports of Committes
6. Unfinished business and new business
7. Adjournment

ARTICLE III Officers and Committees

The officers of the Chapter shall be a President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, a Sergeant at Arms.

Sec. 2. There shall be an Executive Committee, of which the elected Chapter officers shall be members. The Executive Committee shall exercise such functions as the Chapter may prescribe.

Sec. 3. The President may appoint an Auditing Committee, a Nominating Committee and such other committees as may be deemed desirable.

Sec. 4. The Chapter may by resolution require the Treasurer to give bond for the faithful performance of his duties. All money shall be deposited in a bank in the name of the Chapter and no check thereon shall be valid unless signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the President.

ARTICLE IV Chapter Dues

The dues of chapter members shall be \$4.00 per year, payable \$1.00 per quarter, and payable in advance.

ARTICLE V Amendments

Amendments to these by-laws may be enacted by concurrence of a quorum of fifteen members present at any regular meeting, provided due notice has been given in accordance with Article I, Section 2.
