NARFE Bill Tracker for the Current Congressional Session (119) Is Now Available: The 119 Congress began 3 January 2025. All bills previously introduced must be reintroduced before they can be acted upon. We must start over in communicating with Congressmen and Senators for this new session. Very close attention needs to be paid to all new bills as Congress is looking for ways to cut expenses. The current Bill Tracker is found on page 12 of the June/July NARFE Magazine. Note that H.Con.Res.14 was passed by the House of Representatives, which allows reductions in Federal Benefits to reduce Budget Deficits. See pages 6-7 of the June July NARFE Magazine for more details. Five additional Bills have been introduced which are approved by NARFE.

Note the H.R.1 the “One Big Beautiful Bill Act”: This Act has some provisions which NARFE considered contrary to our membership needs and was asking us to work against it; however, it was passed Sunday 29 June and signed by the President. There is nothing we can do about it now.

The Bill for The Social Security Fairness Act: This Bill was for the elimination GPO and WPO legislation previously in effect. This Bill was passed 5 Jan 2025 with Pres Joseph Biden’s signature. There are 3.5 million cases of federal retirees to receive increases in Social Security payments as a result. You should have received by now a retroactive payment from January 2024 thru Mar 2025. This is a major accomplishment achieved by NARFE and members. Point this out to any persons you are trying to convince to join NARFE. This is a major victory for NARFE and all NARFE members communications are very much appreciated. There is an \$8.00 reward for anyone recruiting a new member.

8 May 2025 Chapter Meeting Minutes: The 8 May 2025 meeting was held in the Lofino Plaza (adjacent to the Beavercreek Senior Center) Meeting Room at 1:00 PM. There were 9 members in attendance. Treasure’s Report showed a balance on hand of \$3358.33. The speaker at about 1:30 PM was Theresa Busher. She is a Social Security Affairs Specialist, Central/Southern Ohio (Area VI, Chicago Region), with an office located in the Dayton Second Street Federal Building. She discussed Social Security Updates for 2025 and the repeal of WEP/GPO. Her discussion was very informative. The WEP/GPO repeal can result in changes to how spouses can claim their payments.

GCSED Customers: The Green County Sanitary Engineering Department (GCSED) has announced that their soft water treatment plan is now completed. Your water is currently being softened to 8 grains per gallon. It was 27 grains per gallon before this program began. You need to make adjustments to your water softener. You may choose to by-pass your softener for a short period of time to determine if it’s needed at all.

COLA Amounts Continue to Increase: The amount reached for CSR in May is 1.99%.
