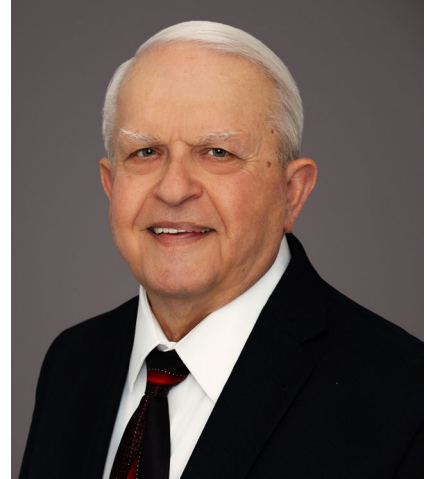


RVP-04 Ed Konys

- Deputy Division Chief of Manpower and Organization (GM-15): Responsible for justifying command staffing levels. Largest single site employer in five states.
- Deputy Division Chief of Programs (GM-15): Developed command's long-range budget, approximately \$32 B a year, 50% of total Air Force budget.
- Division Chief for Plans (GM-15): Prepared the command's five-year strategic plan, administered the quality program that won five national awards, and participated in Air Force long range planning initiatives.
