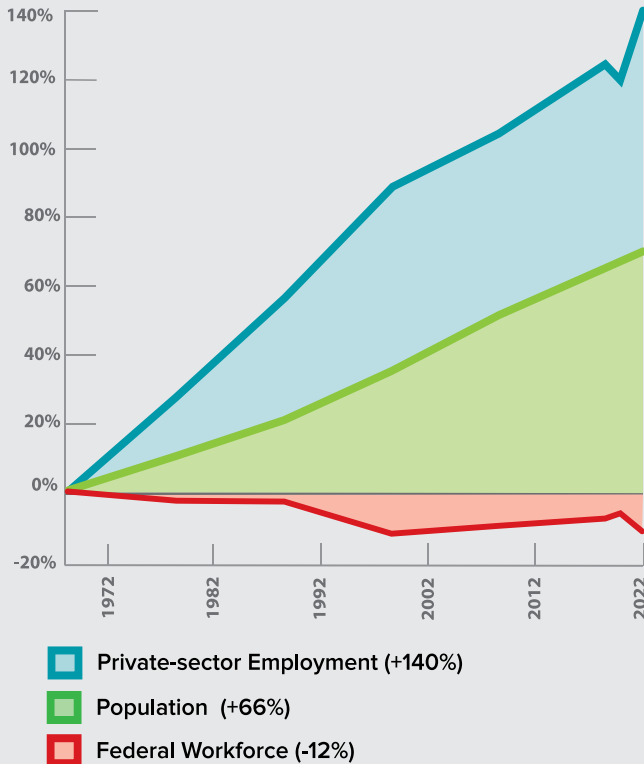
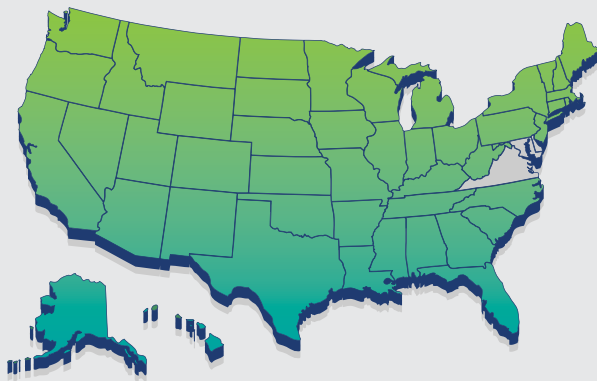


America's Federal Family at a Glance

Since 1968, the federal workforce has **DECREASED 12 PERCENT**, while private-sector employment increased over 140 percent
